We recently had a real estate transaction in our sub that raised some questions regarding the HOA Board giving out our financial information to sources outside of our membership. The HOA's board's position is that, if a realtor or potential buyer asks for financial information or current bank information, we will NOT give out exact information to anyone outside of our membership.

The information that will be disseminated will be limited to acknowledging that our HOA is properly budgeted and funded without exact numbers. We will also let a realtor know if there are any liens or past due amounts on a property that is going to closing and if the property has any outstanding debts to the Southpointe HOA.

Outside of that, we as a board, agree that the membership's funds and security of membership funds is a top priority and we will NOT give exact financial information to any outside sources through verbal or written communication.
